The ProHealth Care system includes:

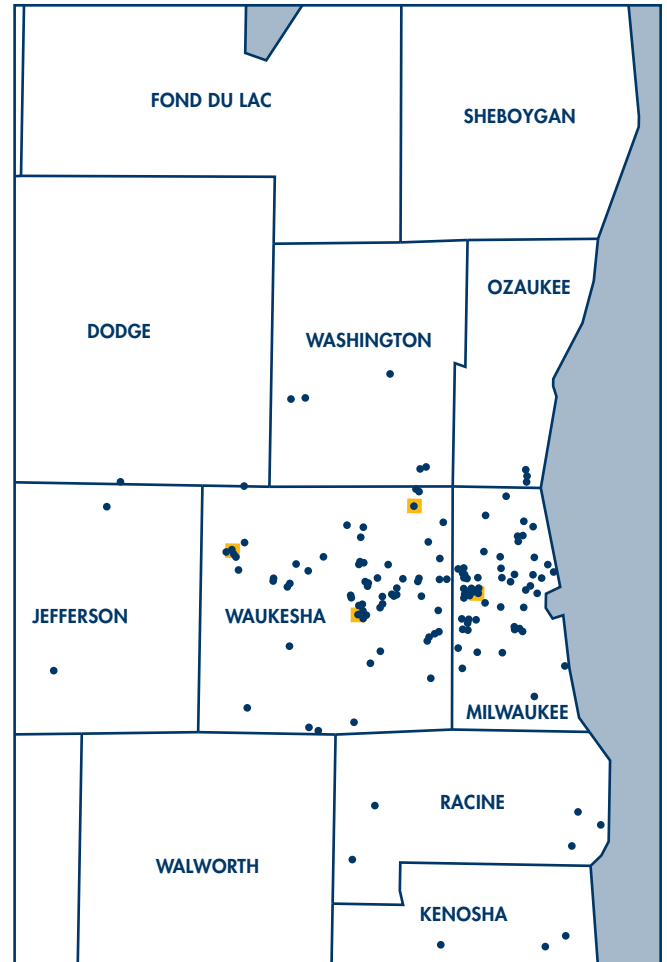
